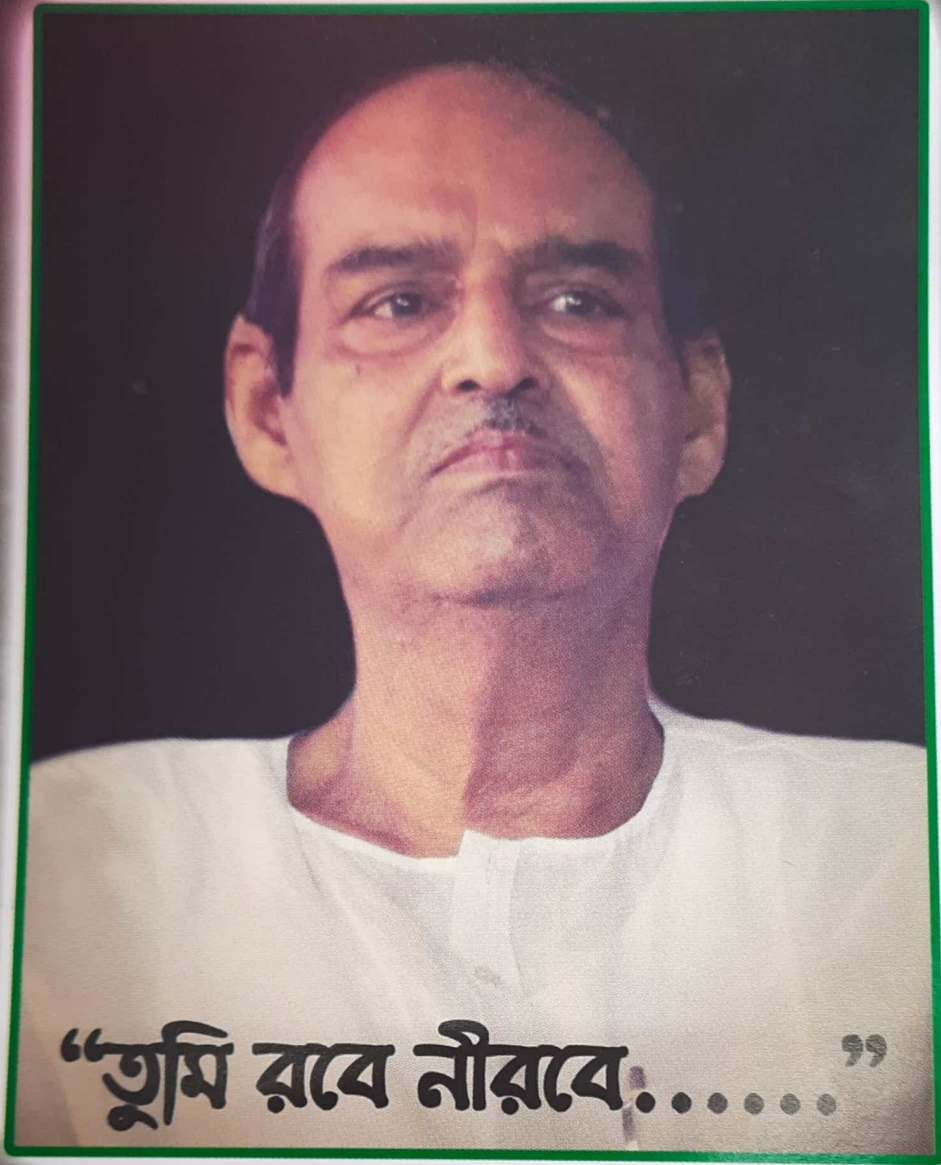

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:-

1. A candidate may be admitted to the first year of three-year B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. (Honours/General/Major) courses of studies on passing Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination in General or Vocational Stream conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or an equivalent examination conducted by other State Board/Council, or RabindraMuktaVidyalaya, or National Open School recognized by the Distant Learning Council **subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned below:**

In case of other Boards/Councils, a candidate shall have to pass in five recognized subjects, of which one shall be English, of full marks not being less than 100 each. A candidate passing in four subjects shall not be eligible for admission.

Candidates passing Higher Secondary examination from vocational stream conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent board/council are eligible for admission **only in General and Major courses (and not in Honours courses)** provided that the candidate must have passed in 5 (five) recognized subjects, of which one shall be English, in the previous qualifying examination.

2. Candidates shall be allowed for admission within 3 (three) consecutive academic sessions including the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.



3. A candidate taking up Honours Course in a subject must have obtained:

- (I) A minimum of **45%** marks in aggregate and **55%** marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.
- or
- (II) **50%** marks in aggregate and **45%** marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.
- or
- (III) **55%** marks in aggregate when the candidate has not studied the subject or any related subject in his/her previous qualifying examination provided all other clauses are satisfied.

However, candidate belonging to the Schedule Caste or Schedule Tribe community taking up honours course of study shall enjoy **5%** relaxation in marks in (I), (II) & (III) above, as the case may be.

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Students are admitted in the college strictly on the basis of merit. A merit list is prepared on the basis of marks in best five subjects in the (10+2) Level Examination.
2. All students are accountable to the Principal / Teacher-in-Charge for their conduct in College.
3. a) According to the University of Kalyani rules, a candidate shall be considered as **Collegiate** if he/she attends at least **75%** of lectures in any subject, and as **Non-Collegiate** if attendance in any subject falls short of **75%** but not below **60%**. A candidate who has not attended at least 60% of lectures be considered **Discollegiate** & shall be debarred from appearing in any examination. In case of absence due to illness, students are required to submit to the Principal, a medical certificate with a letter from the parents (guardian) explaining the reason for absence.  
b) Class attendance of all the students will be informed at or interval of every 3 months. The students / guardians should personally collect the information. If necessary he/she may contact the corresponding departments.
4. Any change in subject combination for honours students must be done within stipulated time as declared by University of Kalyani. From the date of commencement of 1<sup>st</sup> year classes.
5. Students are required to carry their Identity Card bearing their photographs.
6. Any students found guilty of damaging college property or of any other form of indiscipline like writing on/defacing walls will be severely punished.
7. Smoking and Spitting are strictly forbidden in the college premises.
8. All College excursions or outings require the prior sanction of the Principal / Teacher-in-Charge.
9. Guardians are required to attend Guardians' Meeting scheduled to be held as per Principal's notification for an interface with the Faculties and Administration.

## ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. a) Admission to B.A/B.Sc / B.Com General and Hons courses will be on the basis of the marks in Higher Secondary or equivalent examination recognized by University of Kalyani and other criteria as stated by the University. Notification of admission will be made after publication of Higher Secondary result of West Bengal. Separate application forms must be submitted for separate combination codes.  
b) For Hons Subjects, general sections in day and morning section and also for B.A (G) with Geography as on paper, separate application forms are to be submitted.
2. a) As soon as the application is notified (through counseling) that admission has been offered to him/her, the full admission fees will have to be paid on the day within stipulated time., otherwise the offer of admission is liable to be cancelled. Counseling and admission of General and SC/ST/PH candidates will be done on the same day.  
b) If an empanelled student cannot come personally at the time of admission due to admission in a Hospital/Nursing Home, his/her father/mother /Guardian may help in admitting the student but he/she has to produce in details the certificate from competent authority regarding the students illness along with all original documents. However, if neither the students nor his guardian produce the same his/her candidature will be treated as cancelled.
3. **FEES ONCE PAID CANNOT BE REFUNDED.** Fees once paid will not be carried over for a further session.

- ৯) কলেজের নানা বিভাগ ও প্রশাসনের কাজকর্ম সম্পর্কে মত বিনিময়ের জন্য অধ্যক্ষ নির্ধারিত অভিভাবক সভায় অভিভাবকদের উপস্থিতি প্রার্থনীয়।

## FACILITIES

### The College Building

The college has separate and self-sufficient buildings for Arts, Commerce and Science faculties respectively on the sides of the central college ground. Each building is provided with well illuminated, spacious class-rooms, teachers' room and toilets. There are also separate administrative building, library and extension buildings inside the college campus/

### The three Pillars:

a) **Teaching Faculty:** Beside fulltime faculty members there are contractual Lecturers, part-time, and guest Lecturers to meet the exigencies of academic standard and adequacy of teaching hours. More than 70% of the teachers are either Ph.D or M.Phil degree achievers. Majority of the teachers are associated with research activities. They are also associated with syllabus framing, module formation, examination works etc and as UG and PG Board members, Court and Council Members of University of Kalyani.

b) **Non-Teaching Faculty:** Members of the non-teaching staff serve the students with meticulous care and devotion. Complete credentials and information of a college student are stored in computer packages.

c) **The Students:** Against the present day scenario, Chakdaha College students are exceptionally good in all aspects like learning aptitude, behaviour, class attendance, dress code etc. Students' Union is always there to help the students in need. Students' Union generally does not interfere with the college day-to-day affairs except when they are compelled to.

Our college is one of the very few colleges where one will find no poster, walling or festoon inside the college campus. The whole credit goes to the students. From 1972 there has been not a single incident of student harassment by his/her fellow students. Ragging is strictly abstained from by our students.

### Library:

1. The college library presently has more than 22,000 books. These include text books and rare costly reference books and up-dated information books.

2. The college subscribes to journals, newspapers and periodicals.

3. The college library remains open to all college staff and students from 8.30 am to 5 pm on Monday, Wednesday and Friday; 10.30 am to 5 pm on Tuesday and Thursday and 10.30 am to 2 pm on Saturday.

4. **Reading:** Students are allowed to use reading room for reading purposes on submission of their reading cards.

5. **Borrowing:** Each student is provided with a lending Card (two for Hons and one for General students) for borrowing books. Books can be borrowed for a period of 7 days. A fine of fifty paisa per day will be charged if books not submitted within due date. If library card is lost duplicate card will be issued on submission of Rs. 20/- (Reference card) and Rs. 20/- (lending card).



6. Disregard of library rules, indiscipline and misbehavior will render students liable to be denied access to the library.

7. The college has also departmental libraries to cater to the needs of students of respective departmental students. All Hons Students may access this library at any time subject to prior permission. In some cases they may even borrow books from the library after their final test examinations.

8. The students may consult the library book manuals for respective departmental books and check which books are there for use.

9. **Future plans:** (i) The College have already made computer catalogues for all the books in the library for students' ready-use.

(ii) The college plans to install computers in the library so that a student may trace the status of a book whether that is available in the library or borrowed by someone else, how many copies of that book the library has etc, by a click of the mouse.

#### **Other Classes-Teaching Tools:**

The college also provides various, audio-visual aids like OHP, class-room amplifiers etc. to the faculties for presentations during classes, seminars, debates and other extra-curricular activities.

#### **Laboratories:**

College provides well-equipped laboratories for the different lab-based departments: Chemistry, Physics, Geography, Zoology, Mathematics, Botany, and Statistics. Laboratory rooms are large enough for air circulation, proper illumination and students' free movement. For all the subjects' different laboratory rooms are used for different kinds of experiments. Some laboratories have computer facilities too besides routine classes, special practical classes are arranged for final practices, especially before the final university examinations. Laboratory attendants are always here to look after the needs of the students.

#### **Office:**

The College office is fully computerized. The Accounts department is also computerized and takes care of students' Fee Collection, Daily Accounts. Maintaining Cash Book etc. they are handled by the accounting package programmed Tally (9.2). The college office is now well equipped to render smooth and efficient services to more than three thousand students. Any student may get all his/her up-dated in-formation by a click of the mouse button.

#### **Seminar Hall:**

The College has a large seminar hall with a 200 seating capacity and equipped with all modern amenities. The seminar hall facilitates the students & teachers to hold seminars and other group activities without disruption of normal classes.

#### **Identity Card:**

After admission a student is required to get an identity card signed by the Principal / Teacher-in-Charge of the College containing information about the student concerned. This card is a proof of his/her status as students of Chakdaha College. This may help students in many unwanted situations even outside college campus.



**Academic Calendar:**

An academic calendar, stating dates of important academic events such as college examination, final test, class tests, list of holidays are distributed to the students so that they can plan their future activities well in advance. Some departments split up the entire syllabus in different modules and inform the students accordingly.

**Scholarship & Stipend:**

1. Teachers' Council provides stipends to the poor and meritorious students.
2. The Govt. of India also awards a few scholarships to students belonging to SC, ST and OBC categories.
3. Nearly 10% of the students are given financial assistance from the students' Aid Fund yearly. The selection is made on the basis of merit, financial status and class attendance.
4. Students' Union also helps students in financial distress.
5. For the eleventh plan period (2007-2012) 20 SC/ST students each year will get a monthly stipend of Rs. 500.00 only on the basis of merit and attendance in classes. Eligible students must submit caste certificate and also family income certificate.

**Awards/Prizes:**

1. Medals are given to students who secure highest marks among the college students in the University final examination in respective honours subjects.
2. Medals/ Prizes are given to students who secure highest marks among general students (one each for B.A, B.Sc Pure and Bio, B.Com).
3. Award is given to students who perform well in different cultural programmes.

**The college appeals to all generously contribute to start scholarships for the students of the college in memory of some of their lovable ones.**

**Students Health Home:**

Students' Health Home has arranged a regional centre in the college premises with all helps from the college. Any students of the college may avail free medical counseling, health check-up facility and medicines from the centre.

**Catering Service:**

The College runs one newly constructed well located and airy canteen for the benefit of students.

**Counseling:**

Faculty Members are always available to students for open consultation and advice on personal & social problems. Students may have their specific academic problems sorted out with the help of their respective teachers. This offer remains open even after the final examination is over. For getting jobs a separate counseling unit is formed. Last year a number of organizations arranged interviews in our college campus for recruitment in academic and service sectors.



**Grievance Redressal Cell:**

The College has a Grievance Redressal Cell to address the grievances and suggestions of the students, staff and guardians. Complaint and suggestion boxes are placed at strategic points for this purpose.

**Common Room:**

There are separate common rooms for male and female students for their use during leisure periods.

**College Magazine:**

The College magazine is published annually by the students' union with the help of the entrusted teacher. Some departments also publish wall magazines regularly.

**NCC:**

Chakdaha College has a tradition of running National Cadet Corps effectively for a long time. Lots of cadet has excelled in their performance at National level also. Even in year 2012, four cadets were selected for the Republic Day parade at New Delhi. Now college has two units of N.C.C one for male students and one for female students both being run under the vigilant supervision of Lieutenant Dr. Paritosh Biswas.

**NSS:**

There are two NSS units. In unit-I programme officer is Prof. Ajit Kumar Mondal & in Unit-II programme Officer is Prof. Susanta Ghosh. Almost every year our NSS volunteers get selected to participate in Pre-Republic Day camp and Republic Day help in Delhi. Ours NSS volunteers attended National Integration Camps held in Ahmadabad and Hardwar. One National Integration camp has been organized by our NSS units Chakdaha College. Our two NSS units provide a cue to build up the co-operative attitude to serve the society.

**Annual Functions:**

Annual Functions like Bhasadibas, Sharad Utsab, Basonto Utsab, Departmental Reunion etc. are organized on a regular basis. Annual social function is celebrated usually during the winter season each year.

**Seminars / Exhibitions:**

Seminars / Exhibitions are arranged by the college and also by different departments of the college on regular basis.

**Testing Facilities:**

- a. An arsenic detection unit is formed by the Department of Chemistry to serve the society.
- b. A microbiological testing unit is formed by the Department of Botany.

**Hostel:**

Twenty students (SC/ST only) can be accommodated in the college hostel provided with all facilities.



## **CHAKDAHA COLLEGE**

### **Computer Centre:**

The college has a computer centre equipped with about thirty computers. Interested students may use this centre as per their need, subject to availability.

### **Remedial Coaching Centre:**

The college has one unit for remedial coaching for all the college SC/ST students. Classes are held according to the need of the students. Also the students may avail library, photocopy of study materials and computer facilities there.

### **Entry in Job Training Centre:**

This unit of the college helps the students of the college and also neighboring locality to train them for different jobs. Eminent counselor both from the college and outside are invited for the training. Here also students may avail library, computer and other related facilities.

### **Career Counseling:**

A. Career Counseling Cell (financed by UGC) is formed for the guidance of SC/ST/OBC/Minority students. The cell holds workshops and seminars time to time to nourish the future of the socially disadvantaged students.

### **Alumni Association:**

Many of our former students well establishment in their social lives. They are engaged in different occupations such as practicing law, teaching, research activity, service sector, bank service, journalism, business etc. and have established an Alumni Association to help the college in need.

### **Students' Union:**

The college has a representative Students' Union which manages the co-curricular activities of the college. viz. cultural competition, sports, social functions, college magazine etc. Each year they arrange a blood donation camp.

### **Cultural Heritage:**

The College has a long cultural heritage from its very foundation day. In 1992 the college cultural team was invited to organize cultural functions at the All India Integration Camp held in Chennai. Besides regular functions, all the Hons teaching departments organize annual departmental reunions including past and present students. In these functions, all the interested students may exhibit his/her cultural skills.

### **College Results:**

The College is one of the oldest and leading colleges affiliated to the University of Kalyani. University examination results of the college have been always quite satisfactory recording toppers in several subjects over the years.

### **Netaji Subhash Open University Study Centre:**

The College has been a study centre under Netaji Subhash Open University (NSOU) since 1998. All eligible candidates may study UG & PG courses in different subjects according to his or her convenience. Also there are BLIS, MLIS, different diploma & certificate courses in the centre. Students are admitted in two semesters – January & July of each year. All Graduates from the colleges may study PG courses in the following subjects – Bengali, English, History, Political Science, Education, and Mathematics & MSW.



## EXAMINATION SYSTEM

We hold college and university examination in its true spirit. We have an "Examination Sub-Committee" consisting of teachers and non-teaching staff of the college. As per university guidelines, we take Test Examination for Honours and General students which also include pass papers for Honours students at the end of each academic year..

Between April and July all University examinations (Part-I, II, III) are held at our college centre where students of colleges (as set by the University of Kalyani) sit for their examination.

Keeping in mind about the scorching heat of summer, we take all possible measures for uninterrupted power supply, availability of drinking water and medical facilities in case of emergencies.

Invigilators in the rooms remain strictly vigilant all through to curb any malpractice. Even our invigilators don't hesitate to expel a student if found guilty after repeated warnings. We also take help from local administration for safe passage of examination.

### UGC DRAFT REGULATIONS ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, 2009

In exercise of the power conferred by Clause (g) of Sub-Section (1) of Section 26 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, the University Grants Commission hereby makes the following Regulations, namely –

- 1.1) These regulations shall be called the "UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Education Institutions, 2009".
- 1.2) They shall apply come into force with immediate effect.
- 1.3) They shall apply to all the universities established or incorporated by or under a Central Act a Provincial Act or a State Act, to all institutions deemed to be university under section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, to all other higher educational institutions. Including the departments, constituent units and all the premises (academic, residential sports, canteen etc) of such universities deemed universities and other higher educational institutions, whether located within the campus or outside, and to all means of transportation of students whether public or private. For details see the "College Notice Board".
