

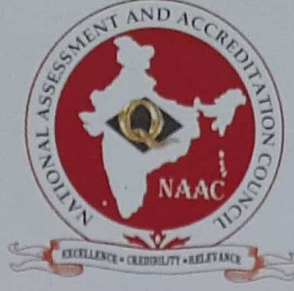



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About the College

A BRIEF HISTORY:

Chakdaha College, established on November 21, 1972 in a sylvan atmosphere of suburban Bengal was one of the earliest Colleges, affiliated to University of Kalyani. The College must acknowledge the contribution of the then deputy-speaker of West Bengal, Sri Haridas Mitra in its making and development with gratitude. In its initial phases the College did not have its own building and therefore the classes of only general course students were arranged in a neighbouring school. But under

the laborious and well intentioned enterprises of some education-lovers and administrators the College grew up to be a seat of expertise and excellence. At present the College runs fourteen Hons. Courses together with a variety of subjects, offered in the General courses. The role of the local people in the formative stages was praise-worthy. Chakdaha College became synonymous with discipline, regularity and sincerity. By degrees, the College reached a certain height by virtue of an all-out effort, discharged by the three wings viz. teaching faculty, non-teaching faculty and last but not the least students. Commendable performances



of the students under the tutelage of efficient teachers and friendly co-operation of the non-teaching staff have lent the College its wide popularity. The College has fostered many athletes, one of whom even won National recognition in the form of Arjun Award. Even years back, from the playground of this College, athletes (in physically challenged sections) were sent to International Sports Meet in Bussan (South Korea) and Malayasia. This College is not only a centre of higher education but also that of so many cultural and social activities.

NORMS OF ADMISSION

1. A candidate may be admitted to the first semester of three-year (Six Semester) B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.(Honours & Programme/General) courses of studies on passing Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or an equivalent examination conducted by other State Board/Council, or The W.B. Council of Rabindra Open Schooling, or The National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) recognized by the Distant Education Bureau (DEB) **subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned below:**

In case of other Boards/Councils, a candidate shall have to pass in five recognized subjects, of which one shall be English, of full marks not being less than 100 each. A candidate passing in four subjects shall not be eligible for admission.

However, candidates passing Higher Secondary examination from vocational stream conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education & Skill Development (WBSCTVE&SD) or any other equivalent board/council are eligible for admission **only in Programme/General courses** (and **not in Honours courses**) provided that the candidate must have passed in 5 (five) recognized subjects, of which one shall be English, in the previous qualifying examination.

2. Candidates shall be allowed for admission within 3 (three) consecutive academic sessions including the year of passing the previous qualifying examination. For example, candidates passing H.S. Examination in the year 2018 will get last chance of admission in the academic session 2020-2021.

3. **A candidate taking up Honours Course in a subject must have obtained:**

(I) A minimum of **45%** marks in aggregate and 55% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

or

(II) **50%** marks in aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

or

(III) **55%** marks in aggregate when the candidate has not studied the subject or any related subject in his/her previous qualifying examination provided all other clauses are satisfied.

However, candidate belonging to the Schedule Caste or Schedule Tribe community taking up honours course of study shall enjoy **5%** relaxation in marks in (I), (II) & (III) above, as the case may be.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Admission to B.A/B.Sc./B.Com (Programme/General & Honours) courses will be on the basis of the marks obtained in Higher Secondary or equivalent examination recognized by University of Kalyani and other criteria as stated by the University. **Notification of admission is made after publication of Higher Secondary result of West Bengal.**
2. a) As soon as the applicant is notified (through sms or College website) that admission has been offered to him/her, the full admission fees will have to be paid on the day within stipulated time through Bank, otherwise the offer of admission is liable to be cancelled.
b) The registration must be done within one month from the date of admission; otherwise, admission will be treated as cancelled. 75% class attendance must be required for that period.
3. All admission is valid for one semester (Six Months) and for that reason it must be renewed at the end of every semester.
4. Fees once paid will not be carried over for a further session.
5. **Physical Document verification:** As per Govt. notification.
6. **Documents required at the time of Physical Document verification :** As per Govt. Notification No. 804-Edn(CS)/10M-95/14 Dated 13.05.2019, verification of documents, if required, should be done only when the students report for the classes in due course. Admission will be cancelled if the documents are found not in conformity with the declaration in the forms submitted online.
 - a) Print-out of the Application form (two copies).
 - b) Original Payment-slip/Bank Challan and its photocopy.
 - c) Original migration certificate and its photocopy (only for migrating students)
 - d) Original mark sheet of H.S. or equivalent examination and admit card, and its photocopies
 - e) Original admit card of Madhyamik Examination and its photocopy
 - f) One copy stamp size coloured photograph
 - g) Original SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/Physically Disable (if any) certificate and its photocopy. Certificate from either D.M/S.D.O only valid for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B candidates.
 - h) Original School leaving certificate.
7. Applicants for 1st Semester admission are requested to visit our college website every moment for any update regarding admission process.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Students are admitted in the college strictly on the basis of merit. The admission process starts immediately after the declaration of Class XII results of major national Boards and West Bengal Board.
2. All students are accountable to the Principal for their conduct in College.
3. a) A student is required to attend all classes. Attendance in Theory and Practical/Tutorial classes shall be counted separately as per UGC guidelines. A candidate shall be allowed to appear at any of the semester-end-examinations if he/she has attended 75% or above in Lectures/Practical/Tutorial classes of the programme held during that semester. If the attendance falls below 75%, then he/she shall not be allowed to appear in the semester-end-examinations. "Candidates having the attendance below 75% except on justified medical ground but above 50% may be considered for appearing in the end term examination subject to the approval of the appeal of the student concerned with medical certificate or any other relevant documents by the University authority". In case of absence due to illness, students are required to submit to the Principal, a medical certificate with a letter from the parents (guardian) explaining the reason for absence.
b) Class attendance of all the students will be informed at the interval of every 2 months. The students / guardians should personally collect the information. If necessary he/she may contact the corresponding departments.
4. Any change in subject combinations of 1st semester students must be done within stipulated time as declared by University of Kalyani.
5. Students must carry their Identity Card bearing their photographs. Exchange or lending of one's identity card is a serious offence.
6. Any student, found guilty of damaging college property or of any other form of indiscipline like writing on/defacing walls will be severely punished.
7. Smoking and Spitting are strictly forbidden in the college premises. The entire college is "No Smoking Zone". Respect it.
8. Any kind of violent conduct in the college is strictly prohibited.
9. Ragging in any forms is strictly prohibited in the college.
10. Damage should not be caused to any college property in any form. College Computer System should not be tampered in any way.
11. Use of Cell Phone during class hours is punishable.
12. Use of drugs/alcohol is strictly prohibited in the College.
13. Bringing outside guests/friends in the college is strictly prohibited.
14. Access to the Girls' Common Room is strictly reserved to girl students.
15. During College class hours, no outdoor games even in small groups, are to be played anywhere in the College premises.
16. No poster is to be posted or fixed any where on the College walls. For any writing in the walls, strict punishment will be imposed.
17. Students should follow the Notice Board daily.
18. Students should follow decency in dress and decorum in behaviour.
19. Students should maintain punctuality in all matters -specially in Class Attendance and Examination Attendance.
20. All College excursions or outings require the prior sanction of the Principal.
21. Guardians are required to attend Guardians' Meeting scheduled to be held as per Principal's notification for an interface with the Faculties and Administration.

UGC DRAFT REGULATIONS ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, 2009

In exercise of the power conferred by Clause (g) of Sub-Section (1) of Section 26 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, the University Grants Commission hereby makes the some Regulations called the "UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Education Institutions, 2009". It shall come into force with immediate effect to all the universities established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, a Provincial Act or a State Act, to all institutions deemed to be university under section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, to all other higher educational institutions. Including the departments, constituent units and all the premises (academic, residential, sports, canteen etc.) of such universities / deemed universities and other higher educational institutions, whether located within the campus or outside, and to all means of transportation of students whether public or private. Infrastructure & Resources

The College Building and Seminar Halls:

The College Building is divided into five separate segments, viz. Dwijendra Lal Roy Bhawan, Acharya Prafulla Chandra Roy Bhawan, Amartya Sen Bhawan, Rabindra Nath Tagore Bhawan (including Principal's Chamber) and Central Library (Sonar Tari). It includes spacious and well-ventilated class rooms, laboratories, staff room, girls' common room, multi wash rooms, canteen, library reading room, students' union room and a playground surrounded by plants and trees. An auditorium cum seminar hall named A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Sabhakakha with capacity of 200 seats serves the purposes of academic and cultural activities of the College. Very recently, another seminar hall, 'Vidyasagar Sabhakakha' with the capacity of 80 seats has been set up with almost all modern provisions.

Hostel:

There is a hostel for SC/ST boys with optimum facilities. The UGC has already granted a sum of Rs. 80 lacs for the construction of women's hostel which is under construction.

Laboratories:

Departments like Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics,

Geography, Zoology, Botany, Computer Science, Statistics have well-equipped and modernized laboratories. Students are groomed by the expert teachers to have an individual hands-on-experience.

Library:

Near about 26000 books (texts and references altogether), newspapers, journals and books with updated information are available here. With the recent implementation of INFLIBNET facility through N-List programme, the Central library has become updated and a pool of e-journals/e-books is accessed very easily. Students of both Day and Morning sections are benefited by the Library. The college library remains open to all students from 8.30 am to 5 pm on Monday, Wednesday and Friday; 10.30 am to 5 pm on Tuesday and 8.30 am to 2 pm on Saturday. Books are lent out to the students on the submission of library cards – two for Hons. and one for General course students. Besides it has a reading section also. Books can be borrowed for a period of 15 days. A fine of fifty paisa per day will be charged if books are not submitted within due date. If the library card is lost, a duplicate card will be issued on submission of Rs. 20/- (Reference card) and Rs. 20/- (lending card). *Departmental libraries are also operative for the benefit of the students within a limited capacity.*



Students' Benefit and Support System

❖ Scholarships, stipends, free-studentship:

The College extends free-studentship to quite a considerable number of poor but regular and meritorious students. The students' union also helps a lot in this disbursement. Apart from this, students belonging to SC, ST, OBC, Minority categories avail stipends as are allocated by the Govt. of West Bengal and India. Female students, on fulfilling the norms decided by the State Govt. are eligible for Kanyasree stipends.

❖ Endowment Fund:

Medals, prizes are endowed by the College to the toppers in both Hons. and General courses examinations held by the University of Kalyani and also to the successful students in the fields of Games and Sports in State/National level.

❖ Classes regarding Doubt clearing:

In addition to the classes as per master time table, the Departments offer additional classes to the Hons. students. Holding class tests is almost a regular practice in these classes.

❖ Canteen:

The College runs a Canteen that caters to the need of students and the staff.

❖ Computer Centre:

The College provides a free of cost computer training to the willing students in its own Computer Centre. In addition to it, a MOU was signed in 1994 between Chakdaha College and NIELIT (formerly DOEACC Society) to run a Computer Centre in assistance with The Institute of Computer Engineers (India), where the students of our College could complete different job oriented certificate courses at subsidized rate. The students having employment exchange card may avail a scholarship upto Rs. 2000.00.

❖ Identity Card:

Identity cards are issued to the bonafide students every year. Wearing those cards inside the college premises is a must.

❖ Career Counselling and Placement Cell:

It enlightens the students as to their future career – academic or professional. It has been constituted with the following objectives:

- To act as an interface between the corporate world and the students in order to bridge the gap between them.
- To act as a contact point for all companies who wish to recruit students from Chakdaha College.
- To assist students in becoming ready for the corporate world by organising workshops and Career fairs for the students of the college.

❖ Educational Tours:

Departments of Botany, Zoology and Geography organize educational tours every year as per their prescribed curricula.

❖ Grievance Redressal Cell:

This cell attends the grievances/complaints, if any, of the students and redresses the same accordingly.

❖ **Internal Complaint Committee (ICC):**

❖ **Academic Calendar:**

The College strictly adheres to a well-planned academic calendar specifying the schedule of academic activities. All events including the examinations are held strictly according to this calendar. At present the College has one NCC unit for boys, run under the vigilant supervision of Lt. Dr. Paritosh Biswas. Many cadets have excelled in their performance in State and National levels. Almost every year cadets are selected for the Republic day camp in New Delhi. Enrolment in this unit is completed usually by the month of July.

❖ **NSS:**

Like NCC, one unit of NSS is run under the supervision of Prof. Susanta Ghosh. NSS volunteers are selected almost every year for participating in camps on pre-republic day and Republic Day held in New Delhi. They also attend National integration camps, arranged outside the states or sometimes within the periphery of the College. This unit helps in building up a co-operative attitude to serve the society.

❖ **Netaji Subhash Open University (NSOU):**

The College has a study centre under Netaji Subhash Open University (NSOU) since 1998. All eligible candidates may study UG & PG courses in different subjects according to his or her convenience. Also there are BLIS, MLIS, different diploma & certificate courses in the centre. Students are admitted in two semesters – January & July of each year. All Graduates from the colleges may study PG courses in the following subjects – Bengali, English, History, Political Science, Education, and Mathematics & MSW.

❖ **DODL:**

We are pleased to inform that Chakdaha College has started a PG Course in DODL mode under the affiliation of University of Kalyani. Masters in four subjects (Bengali, English, Education, History) are being taught by efficient faculty members. Students are also provided with library facility, virtual classroom etc.

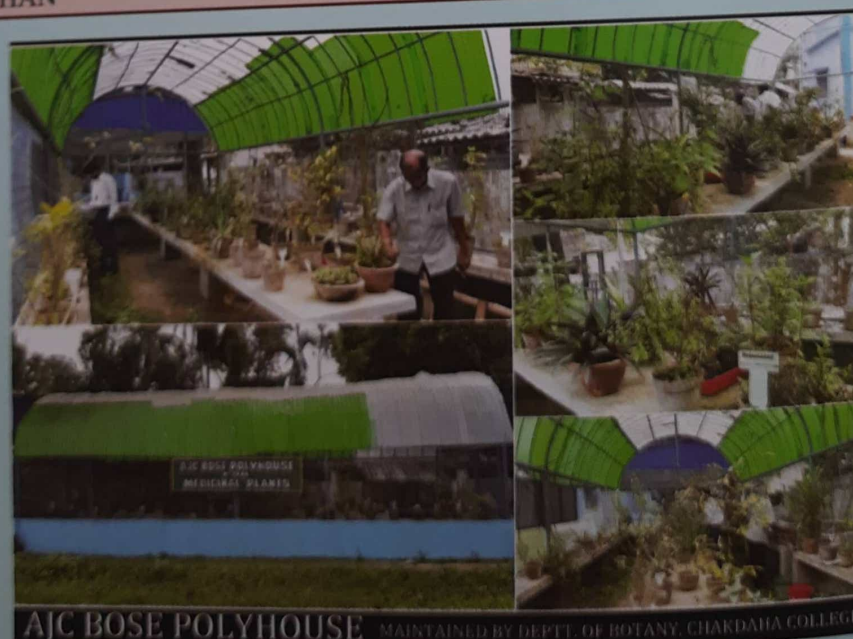
