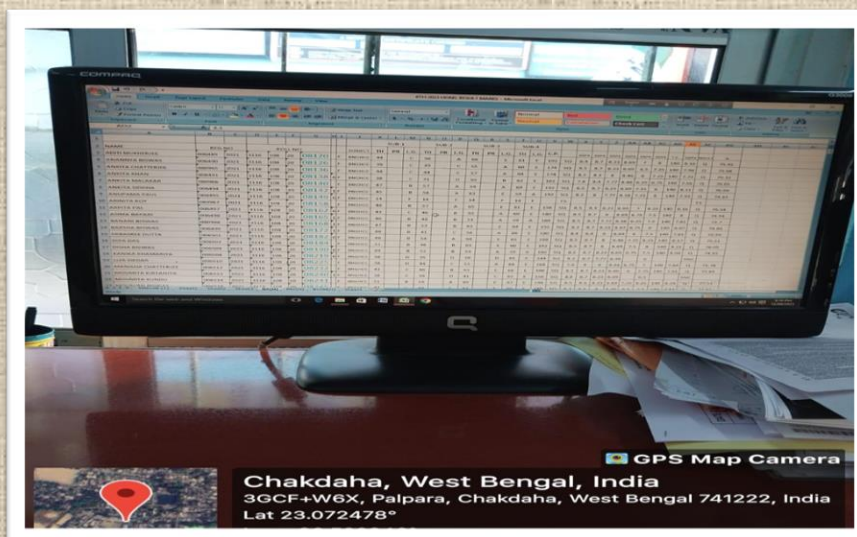

## RAINWATER RESERVOIR (AKASHBARI) AND PROJECT “JAL O JIBAN”

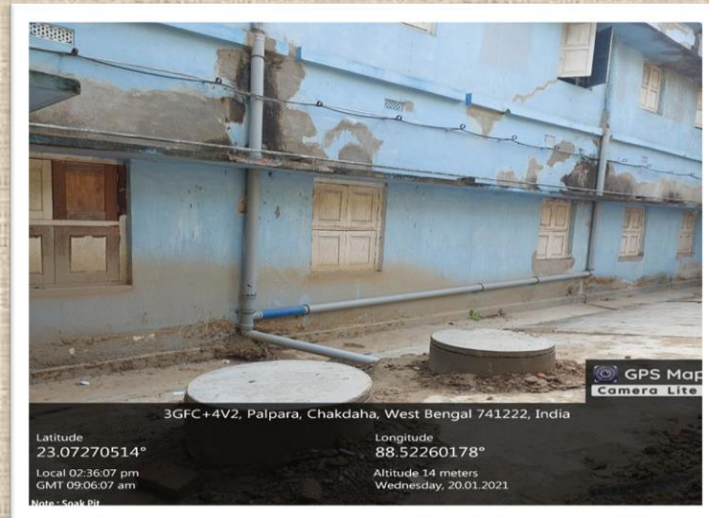

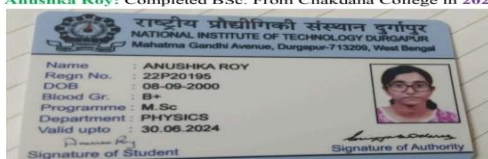
