The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually/ collectively as college/ colleges.

PREAMBLE

Whereas, J.R.S.E.T College of Law and Chakdaha College have many areas of common interest in Artsand Science, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit of academic excellence on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, pedagogy and research.

Now therefore, Chakdaha College and J.R.S.E.T College of Law have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

Both colleges agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on the basis of equality and reciprocity.

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity and detailed arrangements for such collaborative work will be agreed upon.

B. Other areas

- a) Educational programmes
- b) To jointly organize seminars, faculty development programmes, workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- Exchange of N.T.S. for mutual understanding of college administration, exchange of experience and skill (viz. office management, student database management, Financial management &other I.T. uses etc.)

Chakdaha College and J.R.S.E.T College of Law agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two colleges. These terms will include a

technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Each college shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate& fast track the programme on behalf of the Principal of each college further, a Coordination Committee consisting of two Principals and the two Coordinators will periodically (once year) review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between two colleges.

ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

The two colleges will retain and respect individual confidentiality, including those pertaining to the collaborative activities of both colleges.

ARTICLE 4: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Ownership of any intellectual property (including confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MoU shall be vested in both the colleges in this MoU. Both the colleges shall have right to determine the commercial implications, disposition and exploitation of such intellectual property and shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall be possible with prior written consent of both colleges.

ARTICLE 5: VALIDITY

Initially, the MoU shall remain in force for a period of Three (03) years commencing from the effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

ARTICLE 6: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of One (01) month in advance to the other institution.

ARTICLE 7: LEGAL EFFECT

Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the two colleges. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

ARTICLE 8: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case of a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Principals of both colleges will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective as of 13/04/2023 (Effective date) to establish an affiliation by and between

Plassey College, a West Bengal Government Aided undergraduate Degree College with its office at Mira Bazar, P.O. – Plassey, District – Nadia, West Bengal (India), Pin – 741156, established in 2010, hereinafter reffered to as PC and represented by its Principal, referred to as FIRST PARTY, for the purpose of exchange of students, staff and faculty.

AND

Chakdaha College, Chakdaha, a West Bengal Government Aided undergraduate degree College with its office at Rabindra Nagar, P.O.- Chakdaha, Dist – Nadia, West Bengal (India), Pin – 741222, established in 1972 affiliated to University of Kalyani, hereinafter referred to as Chakdaha College and represented by its Principal, referred to as SECOND PARTY.

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually/ collectively as college/ colleges.

PREAMBLE

Whereas, Plassey College and Chakdaha College have many areas of common interest in Arts. Commerce and Science, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit of academic excellence on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, pedagogy and research.

Now therefore, Plassey College and Chakdaha College have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

Both colleges agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on the basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

A. Faculty/ Staff exchanges

- Each institutions will promote the exchange of faculty for the common UG Honours & Programmes Courses.
- Faculty exchange for the mutual benefit of both the institutions.
- Collaboration in teaching, research and development, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest.
- iv) Exchange of academic materials and publications.
- v) Conducting lectures with the opportunity to teach or conduct research.
- vi) Undertaking joint research wherever feasible.
- vii) Participating in seminars, workshops, symposia, other kinds of academic discussions.
- viii) Conducting study tours and joint consultancy work wherever feasible

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity and detailed arrangements for such collaborative work will be agreed upon.

B. Student Exchange

- Students in the exchange programme will be nominated by mutual agreement between the home and the host college.
- b) Exchange students may be evaluated by the host institution if such an evaluative framework for the academic interest of students be worked out, this will in no way impede or influence her/ his evaluation in home college or university assessment/ evaluation.

C. Other areas

- a) To exchange information and experiences on research and educational programmes.
- b) To exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes.
- c) To jointly organize seminars, faculty development programmes, workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- d) To explore the provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff, faculty and students of both institutes.
- e) To use library reading room facilities for a specified period.
- f) To use laboratory and LCT facilities in specific cases (with prior approval of Principal) for a limited period.
- g) Exchange of N.T.S. for mutual understanding of college administration, exchange of experience and skill (viz. office management, student database management, Financial management & other I.T. uses etc.)

Plassey College and Chakdaha College agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two colleges. These terms will include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Each college shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate & fast track the programme on behalf of the Principal of each college further, a Coordination Committee consisting of two Principals and the two Coordinators will periodically (once in a year) review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between two colleges

ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

The two colleges will retain and respect individual confidentiality, including those pertaining to the collaborative activities of both colleges.

ARTICLE 4: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Ownership of any intellectual property (including confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MoU shall be vested in both the colleges in this MoU Both the colleges shall have right to determine the commercial implications, disposition and exploitation of such intellectual property and shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall be possible with prior written consent of both colleges.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective as of 12/09/24 (Effective date) to establish an affiliation by and between

<u>Chakdaha College</u> a West Bengal Government sponsored undergraduate Degree College with its office at Rabindranagar, Palapara, District – Nadia, West Bengal (India), Pin – 741222, established in 1972, hereinafter referred to and represented by its Principal, referred to as FIRST PARTY,

and

<u>Dwijendralal College</u>, Krishnagar, a West Bengal Government Aided undergraduate degree College with its office at Krishnagar, established in 1968 affiliated to University of Kalyani, hereinafter referred to as Dwijendralal college and represented by its Principal, referred to as SECOND PARTY,

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually / collectively as college/colleges

Whereas, Chakdaha College and Dwijendralal College have many areas of common interest in Arts and Science, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit of academic excellence and holistic development on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, pedagogy, and research

Now therefore, Chakdaha College and Dwijendralal College have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration. Both colleges agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, based on equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

A. Faculty/ Staff exchanges

- i) Each institution will promote the exchange of faculty for the common UG Honours & Programme Courses.
 - ii) Faculty exchange for the mutual benefit of both institutions.
- iii) Collaboration in teaching, research and development, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual

interest.

- iv) Exchange of academic materials and publications
- v) Conducting Lectures with the opportunity to teach or conduct Research
- vi) Undertaking joint research projects wherever feasible
- vii) Participating in seminars, workshops, symposium, other kinds of academic discussions.
 - viii) Conducting study tours and joint consultancy work wherever feasible
- ix) Each Teacher will be responsible for his/her own transportation & daily allowances to & from the host

institution.

x) Exchange of non-teaching staff on proper need-based situations for assistance/skill or knowledge


development in areas pertaining to their areas of work, with allowances as agreed upon by the Coordination

Committee.

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity and detailed arrangements for such collaborative work will be agreed upon.

B. Student Exchange

- a) Students in the exchange programme will be selected by mutual agreement between the home and the host college in the field of curricular and co-curricular activities.
- b) Students in an exchange programme may be evaluated by the host institution if such an evaluative framework for the academic interest of students be worked out; this will in





no way impede or influence her/ his evaluation in home college or university assessment/ evaluation.

C. Other areas

- a) To exchange information on research and educational programmes
- b) To exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes.
- c) To jointly organize seminars, faculty development programmes, workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- d) To explore the provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff, faculty and students of both institutes.
- e) To use library reading room facilities for a specified period.
- f) To use laboratory facilities in specific cases (with prior approval of Principal) for a limited period.

<u>Chakdaha College</u> and <u>Dwijendralal College</u> agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two colleges. These terms will include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Each college shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate the programme on behalf of the Principal of each college further, a Coordination Committee consisting of two Principals and the two Coordinators will periodically (once or twice a year) review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between two colleges.

ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

The two colleges will retain and respect individual confidentiality, including those pertaining to the collaborative activities of both colleges.

ARTICLE 4: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Ownership of any intellectual property (including but not limited to confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MoU shall be vested in both the colleges in this MoU. Both the colleges shall have right to determine the commercial implications, disposition and exploitation of such intellectual property and shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall be possible with prior written consent of both colleges.

ARTICLE 5: VALIDITY

Initially, the MoU shall remain in force for a period of Three years commencing from the effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.



ARTICLE 6: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of One month in advance to the other institution.

ARTICLE 7: LEGAL EFFECT

Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the two colleges. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

ARTICLE 8: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case of a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Principals of both colleges will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.

Chakdaha College and Dwijendralal College welcome the establishment of this Memorandum for cooperation and jointly agree to the provisions set out above.

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding is made on the 2024 day of 20th September 2024.

Between

The Central Sanskrit University, Delhi, established under the Central Sanskrit Universities Act, 2020, passed by the Parliament, hereinafter referred to as the CSU, is represented by its Director of the Institute of Open and Distance Education or any officer authorized by the Vice Chancellor of the CSU.

And

Chakdaha College, (Affiliated to University of Kalyani), Vill. Rabindra Nagar, P.O. Chadkaha, Dist. Nadia, Pin. 741222, West Bengal, India hereinafter referred as Chakdaha College represented by its Registrar/ Director/Dean/Principal/Vice Chancellor.

This MOU witnesses the following:

- 1. Whereas the main objective of the CSU is to promote, develop, propagate, disseminate, and preserve Sanskrit in all its aspects through any accepted mode, including Sanskrit learning under its Centre for Sanskrit Learning (CSL) activities.
- 2. And whereas for implementing its CSL activity, the CSU makes collaborations with the Universities, Colleges, Institutions etc. desirous of promoting Sanskrit learning to its students/staff and public within its reach, through CSL Centre along with other similar academic activities at their organisation.
- 3. And whereas, pursuant to the proposal submitted by Chakdaha College for the operation of a CSL Centre, the CSU intends to collaborate with it to establish the CSL Centre on its premises and sign this MoU accordingly.
- 4. And whereas, the CSU will provide the following facilities, arrangements, and materials for conducting the prescribed courses at the CSL Centre:

A. A trained Sanskrit teacher.

- B. Prescribed monthly remuneration for the CSL Centre teacher, to be paid by the CSU. (In addition to their duties at the designated Centre, the teacher may be required to teach learners at any other nearby Centre(s) if necessary.)
- C. Reading materials for the learners.
- D. Prescribed guidelines for the CSL.
- E. Conducting examinations at the end of the academic session and awarding certificates/diplomas to successful candidates.
- 5. And whereas, the CSU will offer Sanskrit education through a Certificate Course and a Diploma Course in Sanskrit Language, each with a duration of one year, for learners at the CSL Centre. Learners enrolled in the Centre will be required to pay the prescribed registration fee to the CSU.
- 6. And whereas, Chakdaha College will provide the facilities and extend support as follows:
 - A. Suitable arrangements for the functioning of the CSL Centre, including seating arrangements, infrastructure, electricity, etc.
 - B. Appointing a faculty member as the authorized officer to coordinate the functioning of the Centre. This individual will be required to ensure that the courses are conducted in accordance with the guidelines for the CSL.
 - C. Publicizing the Sanskrit learning courses offered by CSU and making arrangements for these courses at its Centre.
- 7. And whereas, in any matter concerning the CSL Centre or any issues arising from conducting the courses, the matter will be resolved jointly by the authorized officers of CSU and Chakdaha
- 8. This MOU will be valid initially for one academic session and may be extended by mutual agreement for the next academic session. In the event of the Centres closer for any reason, the MoU will be automatically terminated.

Now, therefore, in witness whereof, this MOU is executed and signed by the authorized officers of CSU and Chakdaha College.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was made on, 26 Inday of Supplement., 2024, between Swami Vivekananda University and Chakdaha College for cooperation witnessed in academic exchanges, program development, and research. This document establishes the guiding terms and principles of collaboration between the two organizations:

I. Legal Frameworks of Both Organizations

This non-binding Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is signed by and between

Swami Vivekananda University, promoted by "Regent Education and Research Foundation Trust" and conferred the status of a private university by the Government of West Bengal (West Bengal Act XV of 2019) and approved by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under Section 2 (f) of the UGC Act, 1956, has its campus at Telinipara, Barasat - Barrackpore Rd, Bara Kanthalia, West Bengal - 700121. It is represented by its Vice Chancellor, Prof. (Dr.) Subrata Kumar Dey from now on, is referred to as the FIRST PARTY.

Chakdaha College, having its college building at , Rabindra Nagar, Chakdaha, Nadia, West Bengal, PIN – 741222, approved by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under Section 2(f) & 12(B) of the UGC Act, 1956 and 3rd Cycle NAAC accredited college with grade A, affiliated under the University of Kalyani and Government of West Bengal aided college represented by its Teacher-in-Charge, Dr. Paritosh Biswas hereinafter referred to as the SECOND PARTY.

II. Purpose of the Agreement

Both the Parties are pleased to agree to establish ties of academic cooperation to contribute to the achievement of their overall goals as institutions through the following, but not limited to:

Joint teaching and research projects.

2. Collaboration in academic publications, research activities, field trips, etc.

3. Visits, training, and exchange of faculty, staff, and students.

Joint educational/vocational courses.

5. Joint consultancy, PhD supervision, scientific publications.

6. Co-host and participate in conferences, seminars, symposiums, and workshops.

7. Social and cultural programs.

8. Any other academic activity mutually agreed upon and beneficial to both.

III. Execution of the Agreement

The specific activities to be carried out under this agreement will be stated in corresponding specific sub-agreements. Such specific sub-agreements, once approved by both parties, will be attached as annexes to this agreement.

The sub-agreements between both Parties will specify their objectives, conditions, ways of execution, financial support, the period the sub-agreement will be in effect, and administrative responsibility within each institution.

IV. Term and Expiration of the Agreement

It is understood that this agreement will come into effect after being signed by both Parties and will be established for a period of five years. After these five years it will be automatically extended for same period, unless one of the Parties expresses an intention (by written notification) to cancel the agreement at least 90 days before the expiry date. The amendment, termination and expiration of this MoU will not affect the terms of activities ongoing at the time of notification of amendment, termination or expiration, unless otherwise agreed upon between the Parties.







Any additions, changes, or deletions to this document must be approved by the representatives of both Parties. All notices shall be in writing and shall be directed to these representatives.

NON-EXCLUSIVITY:

This Agreement is a non-exclusive agreement, and both parties remain free to enter into similar agreements with third parties.

VI. SPECIAL PROVISIONS

- 1. On a case-by-case basis, Each party will get approval from the other party in writing before using the latter's name and logo for the activities hereunder.
- 2. All parties hereto shall do their utmost to ensure the smooth and efficient implementation of the programs.
- 3. The parties will consult with each other for any subsequent associated agreement informally and attempt to resolve disputes or misunderstandings that may arise in the administration of this MoU or any subsequent associated agreement informally.
- 4. Neither party can misuse this MoU by involving the name of the other without the written consent of the other party.
- 5. There will be no financial involvement by either of the parties.

VII. DISPUTES

If any dispute arises concerning the MoU, in that case, both organizations will discuss and settle the matter amicably.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

A Basic Computer Course of 6(Six) months' duration will be introduced from 2024-25 session for all 1st year students of **Chakdaha College**. **The Institute of Computer Engineers (India), A Unit of Techno India Group**, 33A, Chowringhee Road, Chatterjee International Centre, Kolkata-700071 has been assigned the responsibility of conducting the same course with the following terms and conditions for this session **2024-25**.

- 1. The course fee of Rs.200/- for each student will be paid by the College through Cheque/DD in favour of **The Institute of Computer Engineers (India)** after the completion of the course.
- 2. Each student admitted to the course will get one period of theory and one period of practical classes each week of 6 months during the 1st year classes. During practical classes two students will be allotted one computer for their Computer Courses.
- 3. Theory and practical classes will be held according to college routine. However, if the number of students of any subject is more than the maximum number of computers that may be provided, the centre will arrange practical classes for the rest of the students according to the convenience of the students without disturbing the original College routine.

The syllabus of the course will include Windws10, Libre Office, Introduction to Internet & WWW and Introduction to AI(Artificial Intelligence) for all stream.



- 5. After 6 months' of successful completion of the course all the participating students will be handed over a certificate of merit jointly signed by the Chakdaha College and The Institute of Computer Engineers (India). After completion of course interested students may sit for online examination conducted by NIELIT (National Institute of Electronics & Information Technology), Government of India with and additional examination and registration fees.
- 6. There will be a **monitoring cell** formed by the College Authority to monitor the smooth running of the course.

Both parties Principal/Teacher-in-Charge and The Institute of Computer Engineers (India) do hereby agree to abide by the above terms and conditions.
