4. **Initiation of value added course (Value education and Indian Culture) for all students of CHAKDAHA COLLEGE** with minimum 30 hours lecture including both Theory and Practical classes whereas RKMVCC will help to adopt the teaching skill and study materials for running this course.

3. SELECTION AND ENROLMENT OF STUDENTS



The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually/ collectively as college/ colleges.

PREAMBLE

Whereas, J.R.S.E.T College of Law and Chakdaha College have many areas of common interest in Arts and Science, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit of academic excellence on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, pedagogy and research.

Now therefore, Chakdaha College and J.R.S.E.T College of Law have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

Both colleges agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on the basis of equality and reciprocity.

- v) Participating in seminars, workshops, symposia, other kinds of academic discussions.

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity and detailed arrangements for such collaborative work will be agreed upon.

B. Other areas

- a) Educational programmes
- b) To jointly organize seminars, faculty development programmes, workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- c) Exchange of N.T.S. for mutual understanding of college administration, exchange of experience and skill (viz. office management, student database management, Financial management & other I.T. uses etc.)

Chakdaha College and J.R.S.E.T College of Law agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two colleges. These terms will include a

technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Each college shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate & fast track the programme on behalf of the Principal of each college further, a Coordination Committee consisting of two Principals and the two Coordinators will periodically (once year) review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between two colleges.

ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

The two colleges will retain and respect individual confidentiality, including those pertaining to the collaborative activities of both colleges.

ARTICLE 4: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Ownership of any intellectual property (including confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MoU shall be vested in both the colleges in this MoU. Both the colleges shall have right to determine the commercial implications, disposition and exploitation of such intellectual property and shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall be possible with prior written consent of both colleges.

ARTICLE 5: VALIDITY

Initially, the MoU shall remain in force for a period of Three (03) years commencing from the effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

ARTICLE 6 : TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of One (01) month in advance to the other institution.

ARTICLE 7: LEGAL EFFECT

Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the two colleges. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

ARTICLE 8: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case of a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Principals of both colleges will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.

PREAMBLE

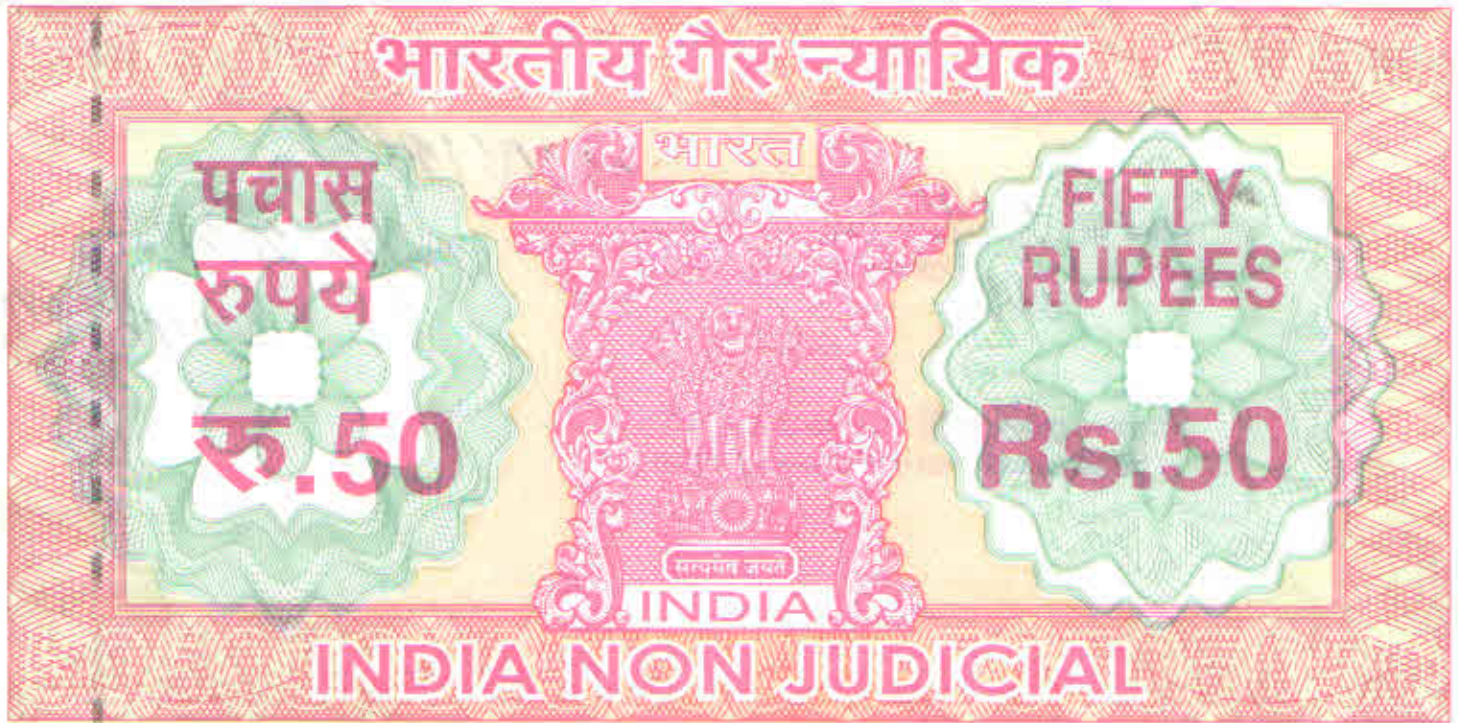

 - (b) student enrolment, renewal and assessment in different subjects,
 - (c) academic and supportive staff working at the LSC/ Study Centre and
 - (d) all programmes of the LSC/ Study Centre;
- vi) to conduct examinations as and when required, in consonance with the schedule announced by the University;
- vii) to send regular reports to Director, Study Centres and/or other concerned officers of the University regarding the activities, needs and progress of the LSC/ Study Centre and to allow visiting teams consisting of University authorities and/ or any person who may be authorized by the University for monitoring purposes.
- viii) All teachers (including SACT-I) of LSCs have to participate in any academic activities as and when instructed by the University.
- ix) To engage coordinator along with other supporting staff following the G.B. (of the College/HEl concerned) resolution under intimation to the Director, Study Centres, NSOU.
- x) It would be the responsibility of all academic counsellors attached to the LSC/ Study Centre to participate in the teaching-learning and evaluation process of NSOU viz., Personal Contact Programme (PCP) and evaluation of answer papers of the Term-End and Assignment Examinations as may be assigned to them from time to time by the concerned authority of the college/ LSC/ Study Centre and/or NSOU.
- xi) LSCs/Study Centres will have to conduct laboratory based activities /field work/dissertation/hands on training (as would be applicable) for the enrolled learners of the University as and when instructed by the University.
- xii) The Principal/Teacher-in-Charge/Officer-in-Charge and Coordinator shall abide by the provisions of the relevant sections of NSOU Statutes /Law/Regulations and other directions which may be relevant for the purpose of the smooth running of the LSCs / Study Centres.




xxii) LSC's / Study Centre shall create a LSC in the college Website for NSOU to store all information relating to the University. All the notices and schedules relating to Admission, Fee-ways, Personal Contact Programme, Examinations etc. will be uploaded on the relevant link (LSC) of the college website.

xxiii) The Learner Support Centre/ Study Centre will put a notice board and signboard depicting the University name and logo at a distinct place in the college premises in order to make the same visible.

xxiv) It shall be the responsibility of the LSC/ Study Centre to submit the Audit Report of the grants received by them by 31st May each year.

xxv) Programmes offered - vide Annexure (the programmes offered by the university to the LSC/Study Centre are provided in the annexure herein and shall be treated as the part and parcel of this agreement).

xxvi) The LSC/study centre will organize Induction Meeting before the commencement of each academic session with newly admitted students. University officials (faculties/officers) may participate in the programme whenever necessary on invitation.

xxvii) The LSC's/ study centre should strictly follow the normal working hours which are as follows:

Saturday (2pm to 5pm); Sunday (10:30am to 5:30pm)

xxix) The college/Highest Education Institution will not open more than two LSC's of two different Universities including NSOU. And it shall be the duty of the college to inform the NSOU if and when the second LSC is opened and put to function.

xx) Neither Party will be liable for any failure or delay in performing an obligation under this Agreement that is due to any of the following causes (which events and/or circumstances are hereinafter referred to as "Force Majeure"), to the extent beyond its reasonable control: acts of God, accident, riots, war, terrorist act, epidemic, pandemic, quarantine, civil commotion, breakdown of communication facilities, breakdown of web host, breakdown of internet services provider, natural catastrophes, governmental acts or omissions, alteration, variation and repeal in laws or regulations that are in force, national strikes, fire, explosion, generalized lack of availability of raw materials or energy; provided that the parties stipulate that Force Majeure shall not include the novel coronavirus Covid-19 pandemic which is ongoing as of the date of the execution of this agreement.

For the avoidance of doubt, Force Majeure shall not include:-

(a) financial distress nor the inability of either party to make a profit or avoid a financial loss;

(b) changes in the market prices or conditions; or

(c) a party's financial inability to perform its obligations hereunder.

PREAMBLE

Whereas, Chakdah College and Dwijendralal College have many areas of common interest in Arts and Science, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit of academic excellence and holistic development on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, pedagogy, and research. ^{Commerce}

Now therefore, Chakdah College and Dwijendralal College have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration. Both colleges agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, based on equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

A. Faculty/ Staff exchanges

i) Each institution will promote the exchange of faculty for the common UG Honours & Programme Courses.

iii) Collaboration in teaching, research and development, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest.

iv) Exchange of academic materials and publications

v) Conducting Lectures with the opportunity to teach or conduct Research

vi) Undertaking joint research projects wherever feasible

vii) Participating in seminars, workshops, symposium, other kinds of academic discussions,

viii) Conducting study tours and joint consultancy work wherever feasible

ix) Each Teacher will be responsible for his/her own transportation & daily allowances to & from the host institution.

x) Exchange of non-teaching staff on proper need-based situations for assistance/skill or knowledge

development in areas pertaining to their areas of work, with allowances as agreed upon by the Coordination Committee.

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity and detailed arrangements for such collaborative work will be agreed upon.

B. Student Exchange

a) Students in the exchange programme will be selected by mutual agreement between the home and the host college in the field of curricular and co-curricular activities.

b) Students in an exchange programme may be evaluated by the host institution if such an evaluative framework for the academic interest of students be worked out; this will in

no way impede or influence her/ his evaluation in home college or university assessment/ evaluation.

C. Other areas

- a) To exchange information on research and educational programmes
- b) To exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes.
- c) To jointly organize seminars, faculty development programmes, workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- d) To explore the provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff, faculty and students of both institutes.
- e) To use library reading room facilities for a specified period.
- f) To use laboratory facilities in specific cases (with prior approval of Principal) for a limited period.

Chakdaha College and Dwijendralal College agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two colleges. These terms will include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Each college shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate the programme on behalf of the Principal of each college further, a Coordination Committee consisting of two Principals and the two Coordinators will periodically (once or twice a year) review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between two colleges.

ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

The two colleges will retain, and respect individual confidentiality, including those pertaining to the collaborative activities of both colleges.

ARTICLE 4: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Ownership of any intellectual property (including but not limited to confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MoU shall be vested in both the colleges in this MoU. Both the colleges shall have right to determine the commercial implications, disposition and exploitation of such intellectual property and shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall be possible with prior written consent of both colleges.

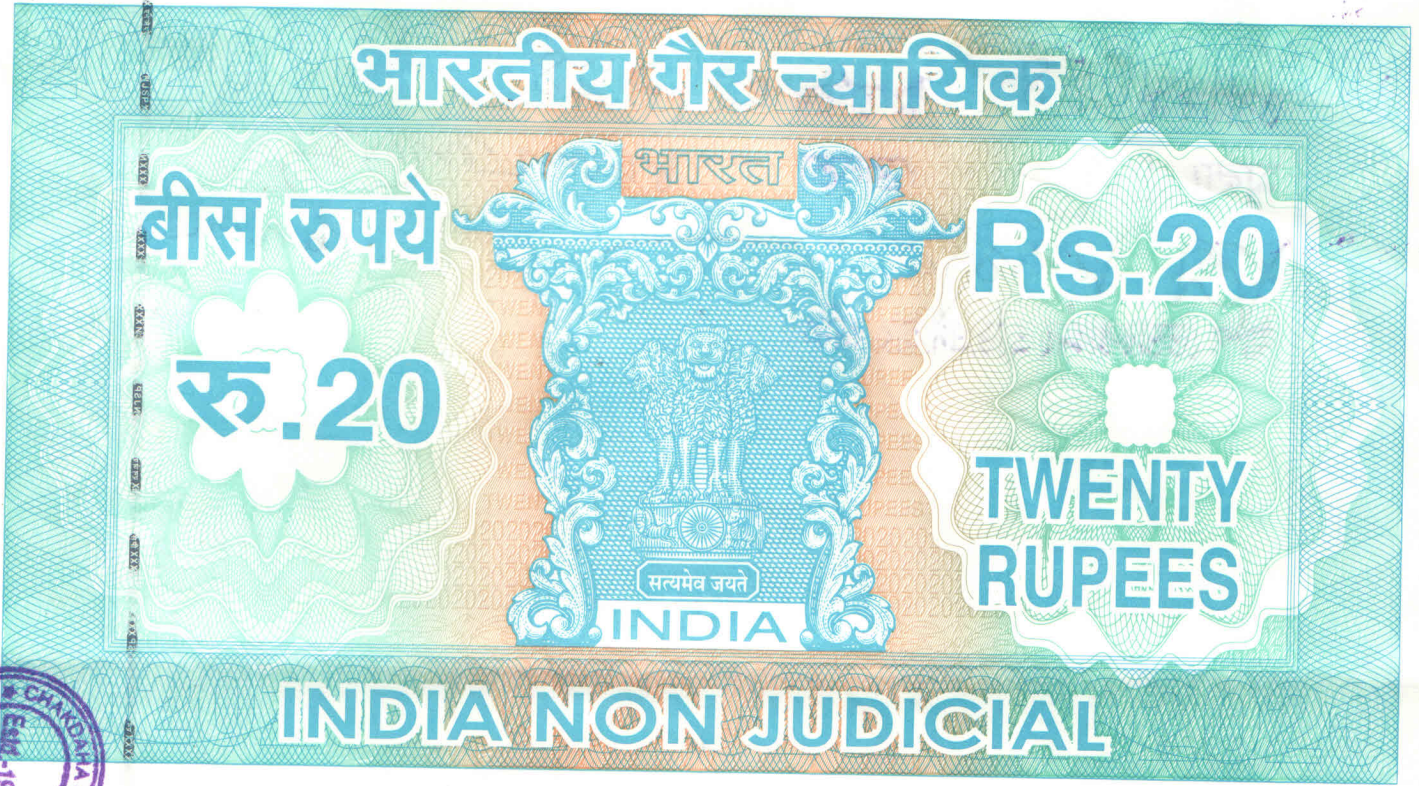

This Memorandum of Understanding is made on the 20th day of September 2024.

The Central Sanskrit University, Delhi, established under the Central Sanskrit Universities Act, 2020, passed by the Parliament, hereinafter referred to as the CSU, is represented by its Director of the Institute of Open and Distance Education or any officer authorized by the Vice Chancellor of the CSU.

And


Chakdaha College, (Affiliated to University of Kalyani), Vill. Rabindra Nagar, P.O. Chadkaha, Dist. Nadia, Pin. 741222, West Bengal, India hereinafter referred as Chakdaha College represented by its Registrar/ Director/Dean/Principal/Vice Chancellor.

This MOU witnesses the following:


1. Whereas the main objective of the CSU is to promote, develop, propagate, disseminate, and preserve Sanskrit in all its aspects through any accepted mode, including Sanskrit learning under its Centre for Sanskrit Learning (CSL) activities.
2. And whereas for implementing its CSL activity, the CSU makes collaborations with the Universities, Colleges, Institutions etc. desirous of promoting Sanskrit learning to its students/staff and public within its reach, through CSL Centre along with other similar academic activities at their organisation.
3. And whereas, pursuant to the proposal submitted by Chakdaha College for the operation of a CSL Centre, the CSU intends to collaborate with it to establish the CSL Centre on its premises and sign this MoU accordingly.
4. And whereas, the CSU will provide the following facilities, arrangements, and materials for conducting the prescribed courses at the CSL Centre:
A. A trained Sanskrit teacher.

- B. Prescribed monthly remuneration for the CSL Centre teacher, to be paid by the CSU. (In addition to their duties at the designated Centre, the teacher may be required to teach learners at any other nearby Centre(s) if necessary.)
- C. Reading materials for the learners.
- D. Prescribed guidelines for the CSL.
- E. Conducting examinations at the end of the academic session and awarding certificates/diplomas to successful candidates.
5. And whereas, the CSU will offer Sanskrit education through a Certificate Course and a Diploma Course in Sanskrit Language, each with a duration of one year, for learners at the CSL Centre. Learners enrolled in the Centre will be required to pay the prescribed registration fee to the CSU.
6. And whereas, Chakdaha College will provide the facilities and extend support as follows:
- A. Suitable arrangements for the functioning of the CSL Centre, including seating arrangements, infrastructure, electricity, etc.
- B. Appointing a faculty member as the authorized officer to coordinate the functioning of the Centre. This individual will be required to ensure that the courses are conducted in accordance with the guidelines for the CSL.
- C. Publicizing the Sanskrit learning courses offered by CSU and making arrangements for these courses at its Centre.
7. And whereas, in any matter concerning the CSL Centre or any issues arising from conducting the courses, the matter will be resolved jointly by the authorized officers of CSU and Chakdaha College
8. This MOU will be valid initially for one academic session and may be extended by mutual agreement for the next academic session. In the event of the Centres closer for any reason, the MoU will be automatically terminated.

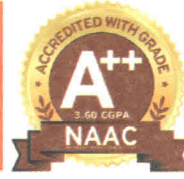

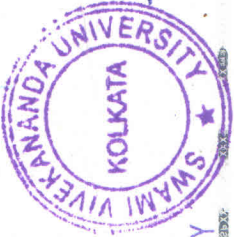

It is represented by its Vice Chancellor, Prof. (Dr.) Subrata Kumar Dey from now on, is referred to as the FIRST PARTY.

Chakdaha College, having its college building at , Rabindra Nagar, Chakdaha, Nadia, West Bengal, PIN – 741222, approved by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under Section 2(f) & 12(B) of the UGC Act, 1956 and 3rd Cycle NAAC accredited college with grade A, affiliated under the University of Kalyani and Government of West Bengal aided college represented by its Teacher-in-Charge, Dr. Paritosh Biswas hereinafter referred to as the SECOND PARTY.

II. Purpose of the Agreement

Both the Parties are pleased to agree to establish ties of academic cooperation to contribute to the achievement of their overall goals as institutions through the following, but not limited to:

1. Joint teaching and research projects.
2. Collaboration in academic publications, research activities, field trips, etc.
3. Visits, training, and exchange of faculty, staff, and students.
4. Joint educational/vocational courses.
5. Joint consultancy, PhD supervision, scientific publications.
6. Co-host and participate in conferences, seminars, symposiums, and workshops.

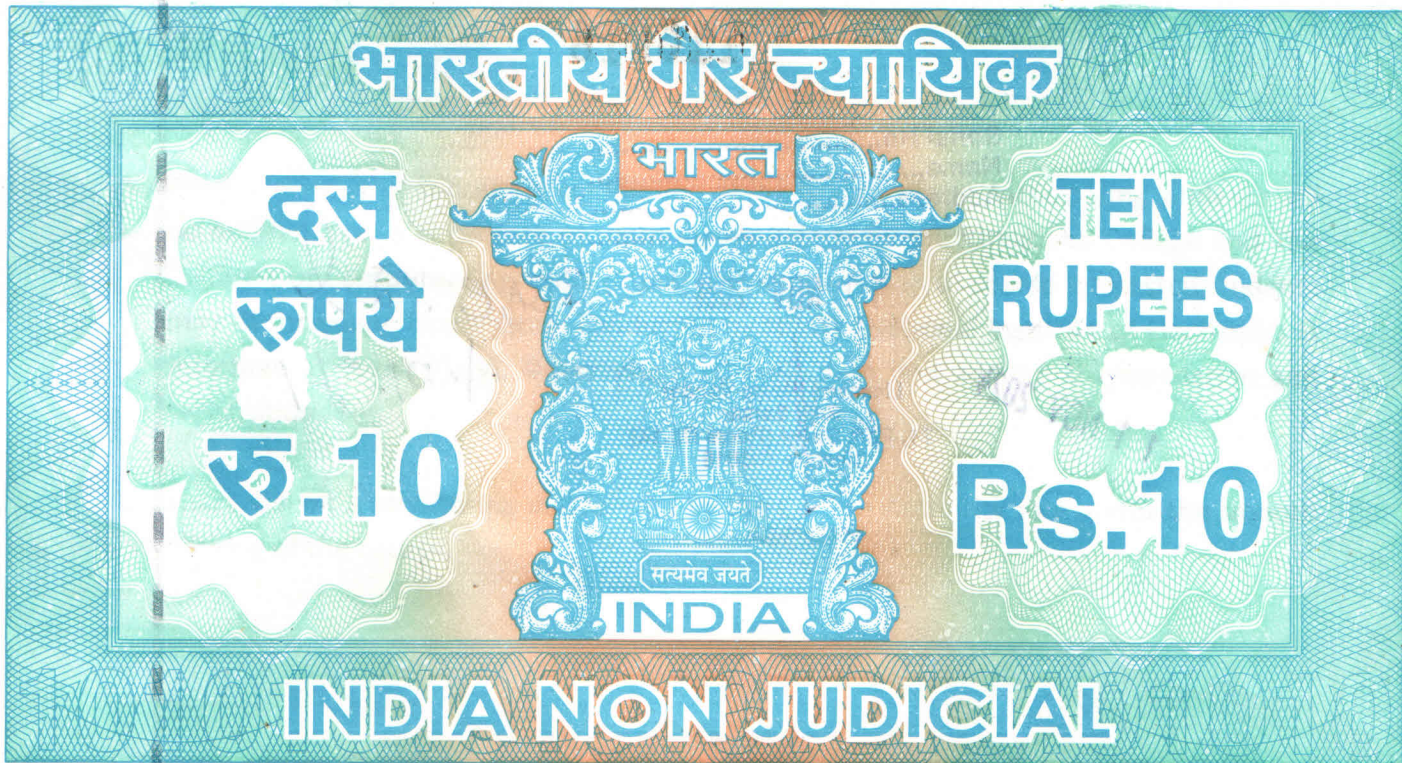
