Report on NCC Programmes Organized by Chakdaha College (2023-2024)

The NCC Unit of Chakdaha College successfully organized two significant programs—Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose's Birth Anniversary on 23rd January 2024 and Republic Day on 26th January 2024. These events were conducted with great enthusiasm and discipline, reflecting the values of patriotism, leadership, and civic responsibility that the NCC embodies.

Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose's Birth Anniversary Celebration (23.01.2024)

The NCC Unit organized a grand celebration to honour the legacy of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, one of India's most revered freedom fighters. The program commenced with the ceremonial hoisting of the National Flag, symbolizing the ideals of independence and sovereignty for which Netaji tirelessly fought. A floral tribute was offered to Netaji's portrait, paying homage to his unwavering dedication to the nation.

Both programs left a profound impact on the participants and the audience:

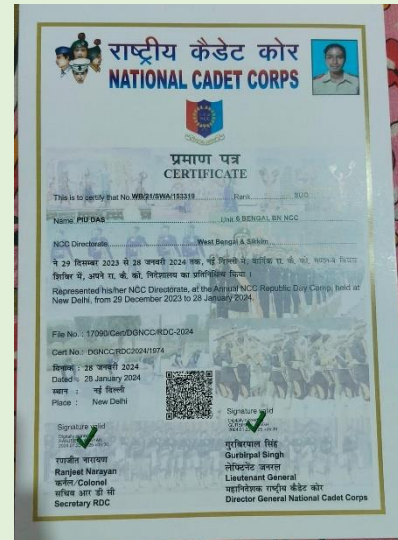
- The cadets were inspired to embody the values of discipline, leadership, and patriotism.

1. Republic Day Camp (RDC)

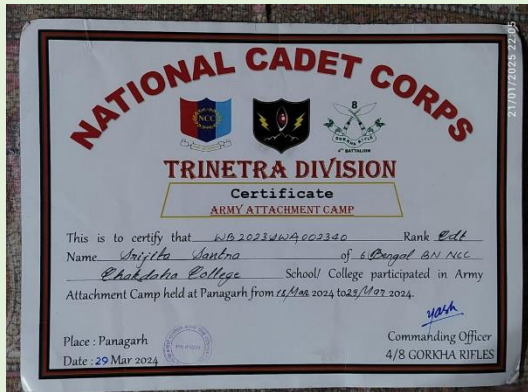
